



Recent figures show that over 695,000 people, due to autistic spectrum conditions, have difficulties in communication and social understanding required to find employment in the UK. However people on the spectrum can have many qualities that are desirable in the workplace such as commitment, punctuality, close attention to detail, undeterred focus, and systematic efficiency. With funding from Aberdeen Harbour Board, Grampian Autistic Society is offering a one to one service that will help people on the autism spectrum not only recognise their strengths but to aid in communications with potential employers to increase confidence and success in job applications. The service will also help people with completing CVs, application forms, and personal statements.

We will also be helping people to maintain employment that they may already possess. This could include: discussing ASC difficulties with management, offering advice/help service for employers, offering ASC training, or anything else that could be helpful.
